A NEW MISSION IN MĀNOA

On 15 April 2009, ground was broken to begin the construction of a new research facility on the south lawn of the Life Sciences Building. In the brief 18 months that followed, the magnificent C-MORE Hale emerged as a world class laboratory for the study of microbial oceanography. This relatively new scientific discipline combines the fields of oceanography, microbiology, molecular biology, ecology and modern advances in technology and computation to provide a comprehensive understanding of marine microbial life and its role in sustaining planetary habitability. In combination with the UH research vessel Kilo Moana, and with financial support from the National Science Foundation, the Gordon and Betty Moore Foundation, the Agouron Institute, and the University of Hawai'i, the men and women of C-MORE can now address new challenges and opportunities in microbial oceanography for the benefit of science and society.
